

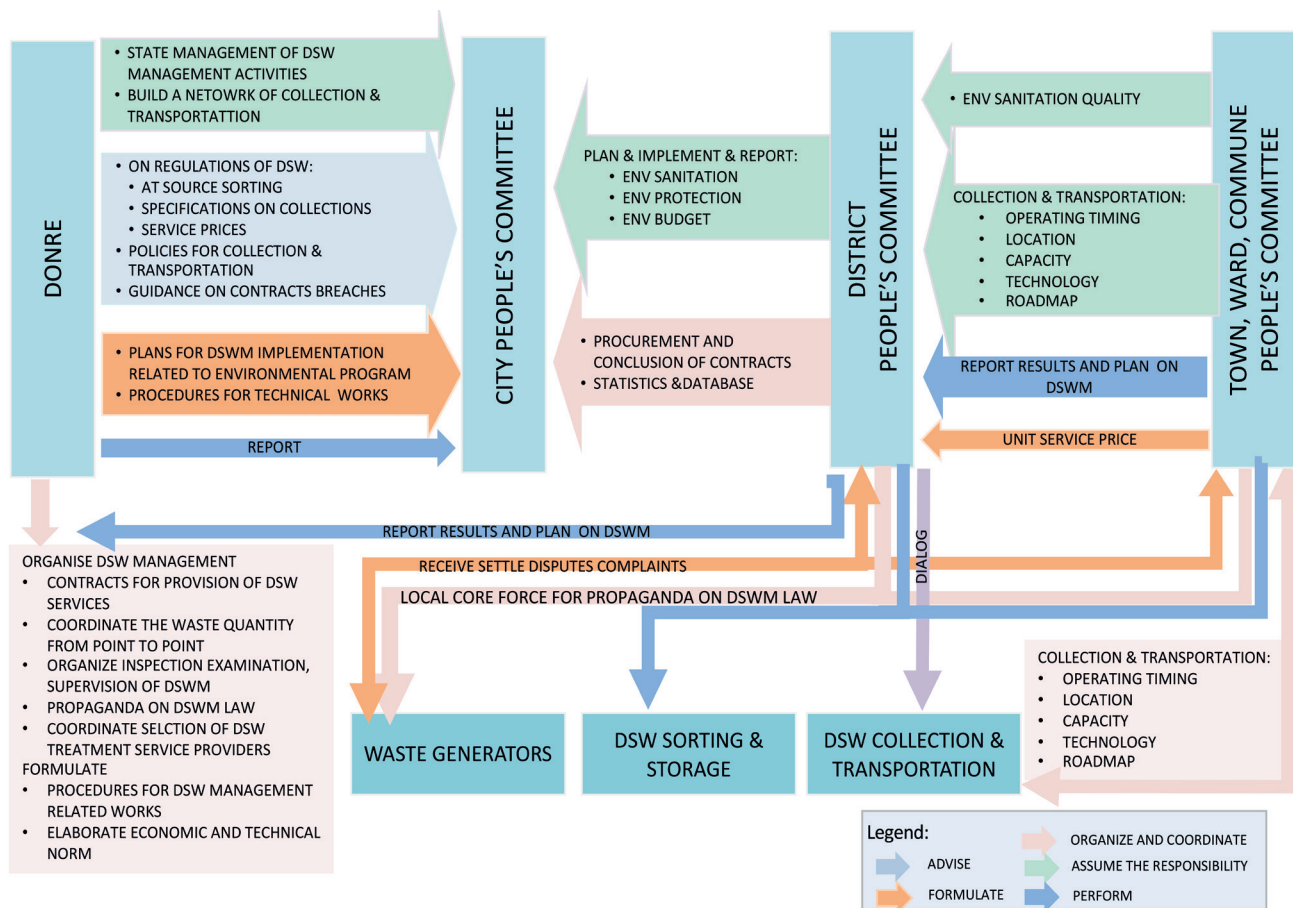
WHO IS RESPONSIBLE FOR WHAT IN THE DSW SYSTEM IN HCMC, VIETNAM?

Objective

This factsheet visualizes the current responsibilities of relevant stakeholders in the domestic solid waste (DSW) management in Ho Chi Minh City (HCMC) and identifies who is doing what and to whom they should refer.

Main responsibilities of Department of Natural Resources and Environment DONRE, city people committee, district people committee, town, ward and commune people committee



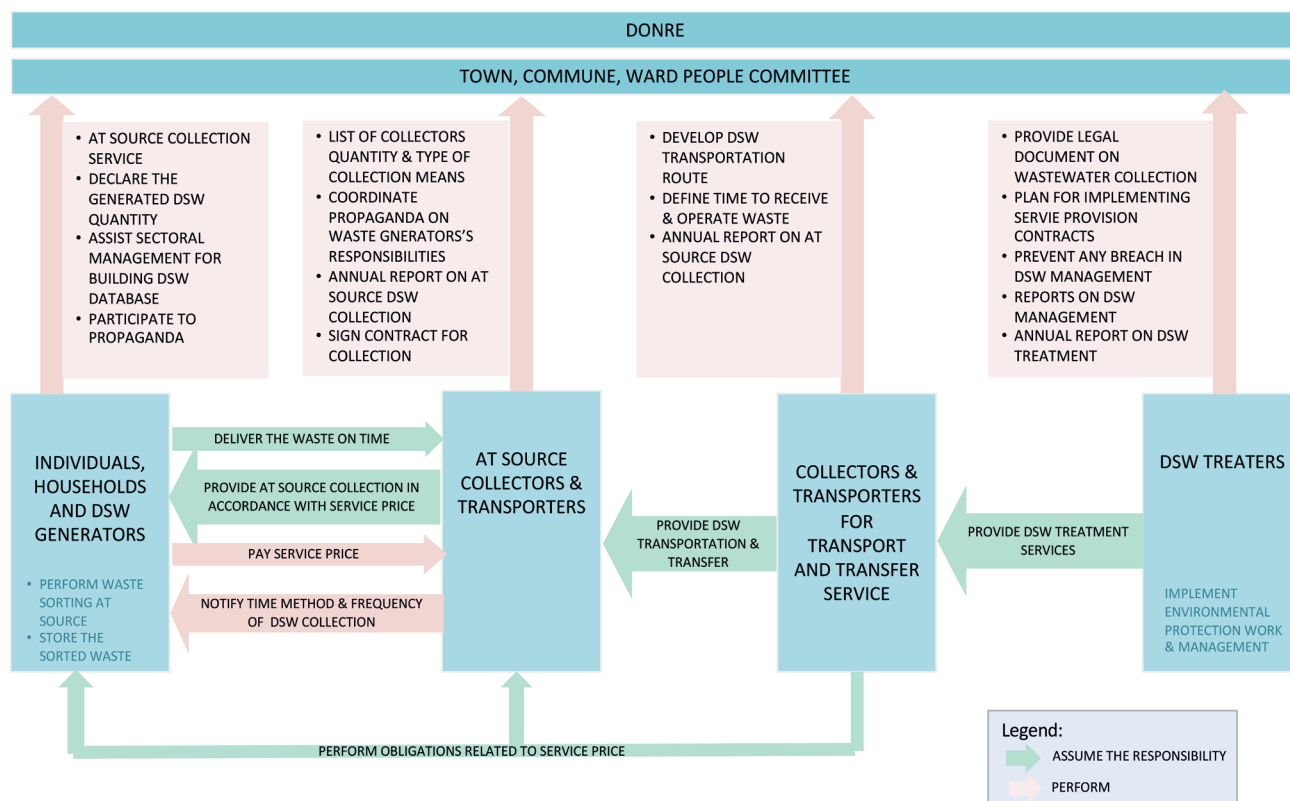
